As the 2022 Pacesetter Soccer Invitational Tournament draws near (May 28 – May 29, 2022), I would like to take a moment to remind everyone of the parking regulations in place for the event. In the past, there have always been issues when vehicles park in non-designated parking places. Every year, the Pacesetter Soccer Club and the Sylvania Recreation District make everyone aware of the parking procedures for the soccer tournament, as it relates to permit parking, non-permit parking, and shuttle services for off-site parking. Adherence to these procedures is essential for the smooth operation of the tournament, as well as for the effective implementation of public safety services at the park and in the surrounding neighborhoods.

Therefore, I would like to emphasize to all coaches, parents, families, and spectators coming to the soccer tournament that enforcement action, up to and including issuance of citations and towing of vehicles, may be taken regarding any vehicles found to be in violation of the Ohio Revised Code and/or the Sylvania Township Vehicle Parking Ordinance 505.17. To avoid noncompliance, please refrain from parking along Mitchaw Rd., Sylvania-Metamora Rd., or on the residential streets in the surrounding neighborhoods. Please follow the established parking procedures for the tournament, as outlined by the Pacesetter Soccer Club and the Sylvania Recreation District, to help ensure everyone has a safe and fun experience at the tournament. These procedures are clearly outlined on the tournament website and are also included in the registration packets.
