NATIONAL LEAGUE

This year we transitioned away from US Club Soccer to the USYS. The benefit to moving into the USYS umbrella is the opportunity to earn our way into the National League P.R.O., which serves as the competitive national league format in which teams compete for direct advancement to the annual US Youth Soccer National Championships. Teams earn their place into National League P.R.O. each season through their performance in the conferences.

We are thrilled to begin this new pathway in the USYS Club vs Club format to provide our players with the highest competition available. Currently our U13 and U14s are participating under the USYS umbrella in the OSSL league. OSSL provides a gateway for teams (clubs) to reach premier regional and national competitions such as the Great Lakes Conference and National League. Nick Smith, U10-14 Director stated, "Playing in the National League allows our teams to test themselves against some of the best competition across our region. This provides us with a gauge to see how we rank regionally and is a great opportunity to see how the best program in Northwest Ohio competes against peers in other markets. Finally, as our teams graduate to the other age groups in that league framework, this will give Pacesetter players terrific exposure to college coaches in a league that has a strong national footprint."

REFeree SHORTAGE



There is a shortage of referees all over the country, and Northwest Ohio is no different. There are roughly 172 referees in the Northwest Ohio Scheduling system. Of those 172, 50 are also OHSAA (High School) certified. So, there are 122 referees with "open" schedules for all of the travel games in our area, consisting of 6 different leagues! Of that 122, the majority are youth, who are playing soccer themselves for High School teams that are now well into their seasons.

While Pacesetter has done a good job helping recruit young referees there is still a massive shortage. We are asking our coaches and spectators to limit being "mad/frustrated/angry" at the referees. We simply cannot afford to lose any of them due to sideline behavior. Please consider the BIG 5 on page 2 as your guiding principles!

We hope to hold a referee course soon to encourage our older players and parents to consider becoming a referee before the spring season.


