Greetings,

As the 2024 Pacesetter Soccer Invitational Tournament draws near (May 25 – May 26, 2024), I would like to take a moment to remind everyone that there are parking regulations in place for the event.

Every year, the Pacesetter Soccer Club and the Sylvania Recreation District make everyone aware of the parking procedures for the tournament, as they relate to permit parking, non-permit parking, and shuttle services for off-site parking. In the past, there have been issues when vehicles park in non-designated parking places, so adherence to these procedures is essential for the smooth operation of the tournament, as well as for the effective implementation of public safety services at the park and in the surrounding neighborhoods.

Therefore, I would like to emphasize to all coaches, parents, families, and spectators coming to the soccer tournament that enforcement action (up to and including the issuance of citations and towing of vehicles) may be taken regarding any vehicles found to be in violation of the Ohio Revised Code and/or the Sylvania Township Vehicle Parking Ordinance.

To avoid noncompliance, please refrain from parking along Mitchaw Rd., Sylvania-Metamora Rd., or on the residential streets in the surrounding neighborhoods.

Please follow the established parking procedures for the tournament, as outlined by the Pacesetter Soccer Club and the Sylvania Recreation District. These procedures are clearly outlined on the tournament website and are also included in the registration packets.

We hope everyone has a safe and fun experience at the tournament and thank you in advance for your cooperation!
